We are pleased to announce that we will launch [Boston University Healthway](#), a new landing page established to assist members of the BU Community in reporting their daily COVID-19 health screenings.

Beginning **Saturday, August 15**, students will be able to submit testing and daily attestations through the Patient Connect portal; Employees will record their information through the Occupational Health Connect portal effective **Monday August 17**.

The Boston University Healthway landing page also contains a series of helpful “how to” modules that guide you through the process for completing the daily attestation, scheduling a COVID-19 test, taking a COVID-19 test, viewing your test results, and properly wearing a face covering.

Getting Started

Submitting your daily health screening through the Boston University Healthway is a simple process:

1. Access Boston University Healthway: <https://www.bu.edu/healthway>
2. Select your affiliation: Student (Available Saturday, August 15) or Employee (Available Monday 8/17)
3. Sign in with your BU Login
4. Complete your daily health screening 7 days a week (if you will not be on campus select the option indicating that you are not coming to campus that day)
